Cody Country Art League (CCAL) is a non-profit organization dedicated to the promotion of art and artists. As of January 1, 2013, CCAL membership as an Artist is limited to residents of Wyoming and/or Montana (*). All artists, both amateur and professional wishing to exhibit in the gallery must have each medium to be exhibited juried in by the CCAL Board of Directors. The CCAL Board meets the third Tuesday of each month and will jury artwork of applicants at that time. Pieces to be reviewed and completed membership application are to be brought to the gallery on the Monday prior to the Board meeting and no later. Following the review, applicants will be contacted by a Board member and informed as to whether their application has been accepted or denied.

**(Artists residing outside Wyoming or Montana currently holding an active CCAL membership from will be "grand-fathered in" as long as annual dues of \$50.00 are kept current. A lapse in payment will terminate membership).*

Annual dues for:

CCAL "Artist" Membership \$ 50.00 (due upon acceptance, then annually by January 15th of each year)

Member Policies

Consignment Guidelines –

No items shall be accepted if deemed sale/re-sale items created or manufactured by anyone other than the juried Artist/Member; **only original art created by the artist will be accepted.** No submitted piece may be a direct copy of another's art, whether the work submitted is the actual artwork of another's or a reproduction of a published piece.

Unless displayed as a Featured Artist, each Member shall display or hang no more than four (4) pieces at any one time. All hanging pieces will have wire hangars for display – sawtooth hangars will not be accepted. Photography is limited to two hanging wall pieces and no more than 25 additional matted photos in one (1) bin/stand/carrier to be placed below hanging pieces. Other mediums will be displayed as space allows; including but not limited to: pottery, glassware, jewelry, cards, woodworks, and mixed media.

Professional vs. Amateur –

Accepted artists will be deemed “Amateur” or “Professional” based on whether or not the artist has sold artwork in the previous 12 months. The IRS considers an artist to be a business or “Professional” when sales equal profit. When sales do not equal profit, the IRS considers an artist a hobbyist, or “Amateur”.

Lost, Stolen, or Damaged Artwork –

CCAL does not provide insurance for displayed or shipped artwork and is not responsible or liable for items that may become lost, stolen, or damaged while on consignment in the gallery. Artists will not be financially or otherwise compensated for any loss. Items that are lost, stolen, or damaged during shipment are the responsibility of the Artist and/or the shipping provider. Artists are responsible for resolving claims or disputes directly with shipping providers.

Non-Renewal or Lapse in Membership –

Pieces submitted to the gallery on consignment must be removed immediately upon termination or non-renewal of membership. A written past-due notice will be sent to individuals regarding lapse in payment for annual dues. Unless prior arrangements have been made with CCAL, it is the non-renewing member's responsibility to remove items from the gallery within 30 days of receiving past due notice for dues. If payment is not received within 30 days, consignment items will be considered abandoned. Abandoned pieces will be considered a donation to CCAL and may be sold or disposed of at Cody Country Art League's discretion for the benefit of CCAL. A lapse in membership either from non-payment of dues or withdrawal (cancellation) of membership will require artwork to be reviewed through the juried process prior to consideration for renewal of membership.
